USE OF TENNIS BALL MACHINE

- Training in the proper use of the machine prior to use is required. Please contact TPCA Member Services at 352-666-2300 to arrange for training or if you have any questions.
- The ball machine should not be used if the court is wet, it is raining or the tennis balls are picking up grit from the court.
- Wet or dirty balls should never be placed in the machine.
- If it is necessary to free a jammed tennis ball, make sure that the machine is turned off and unplugged.
- Do not put anything except tennis balls in the hopper.
- Return the machine and power cord to the storage shed after you are through with it.
- The ball machine should only be used on court 4.
- Proper footwear must be worn to prevent damage to the tennis court.
- When finished using the ball machine, please pick up balls and put them back in the ball machine. The balls have been specially selected to run through the machine and are periodically rotated.
