

Country Club Tennis Court Maintenance

Henry Alexander Robinson built the first Har-Tru court in 1931. He had discovered a granular crushed stone he thought would make a great tennis court surface. He was right. His wife named the company by combining Robinson's initials (HAR) with the court's true (TRU) green color and bounce.

Every Summer, much of our Har-tru surface is washed away by our annual rainy season. There's not much that can be done until the rainy season stops except to address relatively small areas that are especially in need of corrective action.

This fall, Stuart and his staff are going to be addressing the problems that have been created by the heavy rains. Weather permitting, he plans on **shutting down courts 4-6 during the 3rd week of September and courts 1-3 during the 4th week of September** to accomplish this task. It's common that Stuart and his staff will put down 2000 lb. of Har-tru on each court during this annual maintenance. Hopefully the weather will cooperate and Stuart can bring the courts back to the condition that we have come to expect for our fall play.
